Officer Oath of Duties

The Officers of the RMSST Student Council take their jobs very seriously. As campus leaders, we set and maintain a series of standards that we believe to be representative of today's youthful leaders. Each member signs a contract that states the following:

- I am committed to do my share of the work and keep my commitments. This includes attending ALL meetings. The meetings will be held on Mondays from 3:10 p.m. to 4:10 p.m. in room 811. I understand that missing will result in a loss of 3 points issued by the Parliamentarian.
- I will attend all Executive Council meetings that will be held on at an agreed upon time by all E.C. members schedules. Meetings will be planned for a semester at a time.
- I understand that if I can not attend a meeting or schedule event that I will notify the Parliamentarian 48 hours in advance to avoid point deductions.
- I will keep in contact with Miss Gary on an almost daily basis to maintain the flow of information that is necessary to having this organization run smoothly.
- I will maintain an organized and detailed Officer binder to pass down to the next person to hold the office.
- I will make sure the MASA office stays neat, orderly, and stocked with supplies.
- I will use my Officer privileges wisely.
- I will fulfill the duties my office with professionalism and promptness.
- I will seek to mentor younger members into the hopes of becoming future Officers in this organization.
- I will be available for travel to leadership conferences such as SASC, GASC, and LEAD. If I am a returning member to one of these conferences, I will present a workshop.
- I will help to actively plan the RMSST Leadership Retreat held in September of each school year.
- The RMSST Extracurricular Policy states that any student with one or more grades below 75% will not be permitted to participate in any RMSST extracurricular activities. If for any reason, my grades fall below 75%, I will be removed from office and will lose privileges. I will have to go before the Judicial Committee and may be removed from this organization.
- I understand and accept that if my personal conduct is unbecoming of a student leader, I will go before the Judicial Committee. This includes truancies, excessive tardies, fighting, the use of fire arms, drugs or alcohol, cheating, stealing, time spent in ISS, OSS, teacher detentions, disrespect to faculty and administration, or any other disciplinary infractions, especially at school or in relation to any school activity.
- I am a liaison between the student body and the administration, and I will work to create win/win activities through communication and consideration. (seek first to understand)
